
History

In 1793 Alexander Mackenzie made the first continental crossing reaching Bella Coola. Simon Fraser explored and mapped the Fraser River down to its mouth in 1808. Mapmaker David Thompson explored the route of the Columbia River in 1811. These explorations were commissioned by the North West Company. U. S. President Thomas Jefferson commissioned the 1805 Lewis and Clark expedition. In 1811 the Pacific Fur Company sent an "over-lander" crew to retrace most of the path of the earlier expedition to the mouth of the Columbia and then join a company ship to build a post, Fort Astoria. The Tonquin came oversea via Cape Horn to supply and operate the Fort. These land expeditions all mapped the way for subsequent land explorations and the building of early settlements.

In 1804 the US Flag had 15 stars. Kentucky entered as the 15th state in 1792.
