Dr. Allen's buggy stands before you. He used it for his outpatient work. Making house calls was difficult but often necessary as the ill had no transportation themselves. He also used a canoe and was known as the "canoe doctor."

The earliest transportation to Camano Island was by water. This ferry connected Camano to the mainland and was located east of the present Mark Clark Bridge. By 1909 the first bridge was built.
